Place Value

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in 10s
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (10s, 1s)
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems

Addition and Subtraction

- Solve problems with addition and subtraction:
- Use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently
- Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction

Shape

- Identify and describe the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, including the number of sides, and line symmetry in a vertical line
- Identify 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes
- Compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects
