Our Vision and Rationale

The evolving educational landscape highlights the increasing need for specialist provision for children who struggle within traditional classroom settings. Many pupils with specific learning differences, such as dyslexia, dysgraphia and dyscalculia, and Neurodevelopmental conditions such as Autism, require a personalised approach that recognises their strengths and supports their unique challenges.

The Woodlands Learning Centre will act as a bridge between mainstream and specialist education, ensuring children receive the right level of support in a nurturing and structured setting. Pupils will benefit from accessing the wider facilities and co-curricular offering at St Joseph's In The Park such as our swimming pool, sports pitches, Forest School, music and drama lessons.

- Are neurodiverse and need structured and nurturing support to flourish
- Require an alternative to traditional education, where their strengths are recognised and nurtured

- Have EHCPs but struggle in larger mainstream classes
- Would benefit from a tranquil and structured learning environment that fosters confidence and a positive attitude towards learning
